Penacook has it's own elementary, middle and high schools.

Penacook Elementary, located at 60 Village St., is reported to be one of the only schools in the state of NH to show a steady and positive increase in young students each year. It provides excellent education for grades K through 5. For more information, call (603) 753-4891



Rich History



The Village of Penacook was originally known as Fisherville until 1883, when the Post Office changed it to Penacook and has a rich history in the Indian and Manufacturing eras of the

area.

Penacook, originally named after two brothers, Freeman and Francis Fisher, is at the north end of Concord where the Contoocook and Merrimack Rivers meet, which made the area an ideal location for manufacturing. In 1835, the Fishers purchased land and water rights for the Contoocook Manufacturing and Mechanics Company and erected a stone cotton mill named the Penacook Mill. This led to the existing street patterns and large number of homes we enjoy today.

By 1845 when a new dam was built, Penacook had become a prosperous manufacturing and commercial town. Soon after Penacook established a library, public schools, a pharmacy, dry goods and a grocery store along with many others thriving businesses.

Penacook has been considered by many as a part of Concord although it has its own telephone exchange (753), its own zip code (03303), its own school district (Merrimack Valley Regional School District) and its own branch of the Public Library.

As you will learn during your visit, Penacook is a special village with unique people, places and perspectives.

Historical Interests



Penacook has many historical people, places and buildings, all within a comfortable walking distance from each other. Whether you visit the Penacook Public Library which was once home to the Police Station, or the Penacook Pharmacy Building, which has occupied the building

for over 150 years (and has an old auditorium on the



second floor!) or the Rolfe Barn, now the home of the Penacook Historical Society, you will find rich history and knowledgeable people to help you learn.

You may choose to visit the famous Hannah Dustin monument where, history has it, a young woman named Hannah Dustin scalped and escaped her Indian captors and canoed her way down the river to where her statue now stands.

Where ever you go, you will find history quietly waiting for you to discover it.

Natural Interests

The Contoocook and Merrimack Rivers make their way through much of Penacook. This makes it an ideal place for people who enjoy canoeing or kayaking along with a vast array of ducks, geese and swans. It is the perfect place for those who enjoy fishing or swimming. There are several boat launches located in the area for those who want to enjoy a leisurely day trip down the river.



Penacook also offers numerous trails, paths and parks ideal for picnicking, hiking,

mountain biking and running. The Riverside Park is an excellent place to rest and relax while enjoying the river and its many inhabitants or to fish.
